Golf Course related (west to east):

Raffaella Rose At Cortez GC – 299 Cortez Road – Open 7 days, **501-915-0855**. Open daily: Monday - Thursday 8:00 to 7:30, Friday/Saturday 8:00- 8:00, Sunday 8:00 - 6:30. Dine in or carry out available - Friday all you can eat catfish, a local favorite. Patio dining available with golf course views. Call for reservations for large groups. Bar is mostly always full later in the day. West Gate area (outside west gate – Hwy 7)

Just outside the West Gate in Cordoba Center parking lot.

"The Hot Dog Stand at the West Gate" The Standard for Hot Dogs - Chicago Dogs from Chicago. Bob will drive to Chicago to purchase these dogs if necessary. Dog, Soda, Chips and Fixings - \$6.00. Sometimes he has a meatball sandwich – very good. There is usually a line. 11 – 2, Thursday, Friday & Saturday. **"Hot Dog Bob"** does not do rain or snow!

El Acapulco Mexican Restaurant - 2800 N Hwy 7. About a mile and a half south of Wal-Mart. A long-time area favorite re-opening with the lowering of Covid-19 Restrictions. Big menu, in process of renewing their beverage license per the note on the front door. Includes outside seating (covered and not covered) nice on these upcoming summer nights. Really good Tex/Mex. Open 11 to 9, 7 days. **facebook.com/El-acapulco.hsv/**, **501-321-1680**.

Debra's Burgers - A food trailer located on the west side of Hwy 7 across from Wal-Mart entrance, adjoining The Floor Store. Burger's and such. Open Mon- Fri - 10:30 - 3:00 Mon - Fri. Debra has been cooking in the HSV area for some time and has quite a following.

Melinda's Corner Coffee, 3901 North Hwy 7, 501-984-5393 – Mon-Sat 7 – 2. The only full-service Coffee Bar for the Village. Artisan coffee and gourmet café service. Quiches, soups, sandwiches, artisan coffee, and frappes. A long-time gathering place for Village peeps, about a half mile south of the West Gate on Hwy 7, **Melindashsv.com**, \$.

Out the West Gate and left on 7 and see the sign up on the hill on the right. Good Pizza, happy bar, have fun and enjoy, on TripAdvisor, Yelp, American and Pizza \$-\$\$.

Top of the Mountain Shell Station - 4401 Hwy 7 N, just south of McDonalds. **501-984-5075**. Breakfast items, lunch specials - \$6.99 Mon - Fri. Fried catfish dinner, shrimp, ribs, fried chicken, fresh salads, all kinds of sandwiches. Call ahead for takeout! Not your everyday Shell Station, dine -in. Good food, good selection, and good prices. Open early to around 9 p.m. - 7 days. Drop by and pick-up some tater tots and a menu. This is a "**Hot-Dog Bob**" favorite, he knows!

McDonalds, we have our own Mickey D's, just out the West Gate, cross Hwy 7, and make a left. 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. Take out, Dine in.

The Great Wall Buffet, 4419 N Hwy 7, **501-984-6162**, across Hwy 7 from the West Gate, (faces west) parking lot on lower level of backside of CHI St. Vincent's Medical building. No well-rounded retirement resort should be without a Chinese buffet. The Great Wall economically fills the bill and includes post buffet ice cream. 11 a.m.– 9 p.m. Daily \$, **greatwallbuffetar.com**, Facebook

Kroc-Coos Southern Cajun

#1, 4501 N Hwy 7 – across Hwy 7 from the DeSoto entrance. Formerly the Italian House Grill, now offering their Cajun delights. Carry-out and dine-in, dine-out. Seating is limited, call **281-853-5310**. Closed Sunday & Mondays, Open 11-7, Facebook.

The Sand Trap Sports Bar, # 6, 4501 Hwy 7, has replaced the Village Pub. Large TV's line the walls. New floors and ceiling have been installed. The grill is getting really good early reviews. The new owners - **Alison and Andy** - and staff are working hard to serve the rather large crowds wanting **The Sand Trap** to be a great addition to the Village. The early line is that this place is a winner!

Sonic Drive-In, 4656 N Hwy 7, North of West Gate, Sonic food for the Village coming through your car window, **501-984-6470**

Home Plate Café, 5110 N Hwy 7, **501-984-6969**. About a half mile north of the West Gate on Hwy 7. Southern dining with an interesting major league baseball motif. This is a favorite of just about everyone in the Village. You may have to wait in line...certainly worth the wait! Clampit's Country Kitchen & Meat Market, 5398 N Hwy 7, **501-204-5030**, Homestyle—BBQ, ribs, brisket, sausage, pulled pork, and sides—more than an eatery, this is an outstanding meat market with a kitchen and a Banquet Hall. There are several additions for 2021: Breakfast is added, served 7 a.m. to 10 a.m.(ish). Breakfast menu or create your own omelet or burrito, starting at \$3.99. The expansive daily lunch menu 11 a.m.(ish) – 5 p.m. remains Portions are substantial. The meat market is comprehensive. An impressive experience, good food, and an overwhelming market. A Village treasure here. Also added for 2021 is a Banquet Hall that seats 50 for your special events and a food truck will be located at the East Gate Shopping Plaza. Arkansas traditional roadside grill, \$, highest priced menu item is the 4-piece fried catfish, fries, hushpuppies & slaw dinner - \$13.75, 11 am - 9 pm, Mon - Sat.
